FLYNN, Arthur E. of Bergenfield (formerly of Cliffside Park), passed away on June 13, 2021. Beloved husband of 70 years to Ellen M. (nee Faselt). Dear father of Margaret A. Flynn. Cherished grandfather of James A. Leary. Arthur graduated from St. Josephs of the Palisades High School in June 1943. Immediately thereafter, entered the Army to serve in WWII. In August of 1944, he was wounded in action and presented with a Purple Heart for his service. After the war, Arthur graduated with his bachelor's Degree from St. Francis College in Brooklyn, NY. He then went on to earn his master's degree from Seton Hall University. Arthur became a teacher for Elmwood Park Memorial High School where he was a well-respected educator and coach. He was a member of many organizations including the DAV- Northern Valley Chapter 32 (Bergenfield), St. John's Council #1345 Knights of Columbus (Dumont) and St. John's Golden Age Club. Arthur had a passion for basketball, he coached for over 5 years with the Bergenfield Town League and was inducted into the St. Josephs Athletic Hall of Fame for Basketball in April 2002. Both Arthur and his grandson taught and coached which was one of his proudest achievements. "Lets Go Mets!"
