Deacon David B. Loman, 83 of Tenafly and Saddle River NJ passed peacefully on Feb 27, 2022 in Fort Lauderdale, Florida. David grew up in Cresskill, NJ. He went to the Englewood School for Boys now known as the Dwight-Englewood School. He then attended and graduated from the University of Vermont and was a brother of the Tau Epsilon Phi (TEP) Fraternity. David met and married the love of his life, Carol, and was married for 63 years. He began working in the automobile industry in 1961. David found his true calling in 1975 when he started to serve the Lord. He became a Deacon in 1992 and served for 28 years at Our Lady of Mount Carmel Church.
