Doris J. Meyer (née Rosengren) passed away at the age of 97 in Seaford, DE, on November 19, 2025. Born on September 11, 1928, in Englewood, New Jersey, Doris was known for her warmth, good humor, and the genuine way she connected with people. Doris was a lifelong resident of Tenafly, New Jersey, until she moved to Bridgeville, DE, in 2020 to be near her daughter. She loved living in Heritage Shores and even played Bocce at the age of 94.

Doris graduated from Trenton State Teacher's College and spent her career as an elementary school teacher in New Milford, NJ. She cared deeply about her students and took pride in helping them grow.
