Gus Lois, of Naples Florida, formerly of Tenafly, New Jersey, passed from this life on January 10, 2023, after a battle with cancer at age 77.

Gus was born on June 26, 1945 in Manhattan where he grew up and then lived in Astoria Queens from his adolescence until he was 25. He held a Masters degree in physics from NJIT and an undergraduate degree in physics, Summa Cum Laude, from Fairleigh Dickinson University. Gus was the son of Greek immigrants and the first in his family to earn a college degree. He committed his professional life to science education, primarily as a respected physics teacher on the faculty at Cresskill High School. He was a faithful Orthodox Christian, a patriot, and devoted completely to his family. Gus enjoyed hiking, philosophy and a good joke. He was an able photographer, memorable dancer and often used his skill and knack for home improvement in service of others. His quick wit, problem solving, generosity and wisdom will be missed by all who knew him.

He is survived by his loving wife, Susan Lois nee Susan Crane, his sons Gregory, Andrew and Mark Lois, his daughter-in-laws Natalie Lois and Nicole Lois. He was a loving Papou, or Grandfather, to Alexandra, Sophia, Luke, Christian and Russell. He was preceded in death by his father Christos, his mother Penelope, and his brother William.

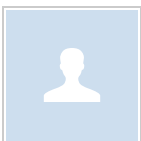
