He owned and operated Harlan A. Blackwell, Inc. where

he was a skilled kitchen, bath and woodworking specialist, proud of the hard work and perfectionism he performed in many of the homes in Bergen County. Along with his father, uncles and brothers Harlan became a member of the Tenafly Fire Department, serving as Secretary for many years. He was a member of the Association of Blauvelt Descendants, documented as arriving in this country from Holland in 1637 on the tall ship Kalmar Nyckle.
