John Lawrence Voegeli of Hawthorne, N.J. died October 12 at HUMC after a short illness. He was born in Cold Spring, NY on October 20, 1946 , son of Faith Howland Dale and Lt. Col. Francis Eugene Voegeli. Mr. Voegeli graduated from the Malcolm Gordon and Trinity Pawling Schools.
