Marilyn Cunanan Levinsohn, our beloved “Tita Meng,” a resident of Tenafly, passed away on Friday morning, April 24th. She was 59.

Marilyn was born in the Philippines on August 24, 1960 and graduated cum laude from the University of the Philippines in 1980, with a Bachelor of Science in Business Economics. She lived for some time in England, working in the field of banking.

When she settled in the United States, she worked for several companies in their logistics and compliance departments. Most recently she worked at Saputo USA in Carlstadt, NJ, where she served as Director of Import and Trade Compliance. She was recently elected to serve as Treasurer on the Board of Directors of The Cheese Importers of America.

Marilyn was an avid theatregoer, traveler, and a frequent fan at the US Tennis Open. She loved shopping with her siblings and could frequently be heard giggling with family.
