### Obituary for Dr. Roxanne Rodney

It is with profound sadness that we announce the passing of Dr. Roxanne A. Rodney, MD, FACP, FACC, FAHA, a devoted mother, esteemed physician, and cherished member of her community. Roxanne passed away peacefully on April 30, 2025, at the age of sixty-four.

Born on December 23, 1960, in Guyana, Roxanne dedicated her life to the service of others through medicine. She graduated from Weill Cornell Medical College in 1985 and embarked on a distinguished career in New York, NY, specializing in Internal Medicine and Cardiovascular Disease, with a subspecialty in Nuclear Cardiology. Her commitment to her patients and her expertise in her field were unwavering.

Dr. Rodney served as the Global Executive Medical Director in the Pharmaceutical Product Development division at Thermo Fisher Scientific. As the Lead Cardiovascular Therapeutic Medical Advisor, she provided oversight and medical support for both the PPD and Ventyx teams.

Dr. Rodney was a distinguished cardiovascular physician, starting her career in academia at Columbia Presbyterian Medical Center in New York and the Mayo Clinic, Florida. In industry, she held clinical development roles with numerous pharmaceutical companies and Contract Research Organizations, including Boehringer Ingelheim, Schering-Plough, Novartis, Quintiles, and Syneos prior to joining CRG in May 2024.

Beyond her clinical practice, Roxanne was a resolute advocate for heart

health, having served as a former Board member of the American Heart Association. Her passion for advancing cardiac care made a significant impact on countless lives and has peer-reviewed publications in Circulation, and JACC.

Roxanne was a woman of deep faith and a member of Our Lady of the Sacred Heart Church. Her spirituality provided her with strength and guided her interactions with all who knew her. The greatest joy in Roxanne's life was her family. She was a devoted mother to her twins, Paul, and Marielle Rodney, who were the pride and light of her life.

Roxanne is also survived by her loving sister, Leslyn Wheelless (R.C.), and her brother, David Rodney (Kathy). She will be fondly remembered by her nieces and nephews, Rich Wheelless, Brian Wheelless (Kristen), and Halle Rodney, as well as her cousins, Lenny and Dolly Fraser, Clyde Fraser, her extended family, friends and colleagues.

Roxanne was preceded in death by her beloved mother, Marjorie Rodney, her grandmother, Rebecca Daniel, her aunt, Veronica Williams, her father, Leslie Dowridge, and her uncle, Neville Rodney.
