Thomas Joseph Kaechele – passed away Sunday, April 10, 2022 after a courageous battle with cancer. He is survived by his brother Bill and his wife Nancy of Lake George and his sister Kathy and husband Jack Kayser of West Milford. Tom will be dearly missed by all who had the pleasure of knowing him, especially his brothers and sister's in-law, many nieces and nephews and dear friends. He is predeceased by his father Bill and his mother Dorothy Joan.

Tom graduated from Pascack Valley High School in Hillsdale where he was a three sport athlete playing football, basketball and his beloved baseball. He continued playing baseball at St. Thomas Aquinas College in Sparkill, NY and ultimately coached at Northern Valley Demarest, the Belgium National Team, USA Baseball, and Rutgers Newark, where he was the Assistant Athletic Director.
