Tsung-Dow “Tony” Huang, 80, of Leonia, NJ, passed away peacefully on June 17, 2025. He was a devoted and loving father and grandfather who cared deeply for his family, friends, and community.

Born in Taiwan in 1945, one of 11 children, Tsung-Dow earned his PhD in mathematics and statistics from the University of New Mexico. He was a professor of mathematics, statistics, and computer science at Fairleigh Dickinson University and led the IT departments for Carolace Industries Inc., and Pilgrim Group. His journey from tending water buffalo on a rice farm to his professional success inspired many.

Tsung-Dow was the unofficial mayor everywhere he went. He was kind, befriended everyone, and helped with whatever people needed—from giving rides to doing home repairs. He and his wife Donna opened their home to many children, providing them care, food, and love. He enjoyed Sudoku, hiking, home repairs, woodworking, gardening, reading, and lately, tree identification.

Tsung-Dow is survived by his wife, Donna; his children Amy, Doris, Gino, and Philip; and his four grandchildren: Julie, Harper, Lux, and Bennett. He will be deeply missed.
